



Merit is an independent, 501c3 nonprofit corporation governed by 12 of the 13 public universities in Michigan. In addition to its governing member institutions, Merit's statewide member community includes over 400 affiliate members which are comprised of private colleges, K-12 districts, library systems, healthcare providers, nonprofits, government and other public sector agencies. When Merit began their project in southeast Michigan, they sought out a trusted long-term partner that could help them scale their middle-mile broadband services in that area of the state with flexible, custom, last-mile fiber solutions.
